Project Overview

Ashford CED houses Network Rail staff, both front line and office-based and is responsible for a number of critical operations including, but not limited to: signalling electrification, planning, possessions, telecommunication, works delivery, S & T and there was a requirement to update this critical function to ensure it remain fit for purpose for end-users.

Scope Of Work

NCCT were contracted to carry out the refurbishment and upgrade of the Network Rail Ashford Depot offices.

The works carried out included –

- Installation of dado trunking and data outlets
- Replacement of ceiling
- Installation of ceiling and emergency lighting throughout
- Upgrade to existing LV power
- Preparation and decoration of all surfaces
- Removal and replacement of flooring
- Installation of new fixtures and fittings to kitchens and toilets
- Installation of blinds
- Supply and installation of office furniture

The works were co-ordinated and carried out whilst the premises were still occupied and completed on time and within budget .
