Project

Hornsey Depot is a purpose-built train-care facility in Hornsey, north London managed by train Operating Company GTR and includes a maintenance building, sidings and servicing facilities. It was identified that the current train maintenance shed lighting was becoming obsolete and a more strategic and energy efficient lighting system was required to service the six number service roads including integrated escape lighting facilities.

Scope Of Work

The works carried out included-

- Replacing existing cabling from the existing Distribution Boards locations to the high level Luminaires
- Remove and replace existing luminaires over "phased" works on a single electrical circuit at a time with new lighting energised prior to works proceeding on the next circuit
- Test and provide NIC EIC and Lux Level Certification
