Project Overview

The London Stadium(formerly known as the Olympic Stadium) is a multi – purpose outdoor stadium in the Stratford district of London and is owned by the "E20 LLP", a joint organisation formed by the London Development Corporation and Newham Council who have granted the main tenancy to West Ham Football club on a 99 year lease .

The stadium is also utilised for international athletics, major league international baseball as well as a venue for music concerts and minor events.

Scope Of Work

NCCT are engaged to carry out maintenance and specialist building tasks ensuring that the stadium is "fit for use" at all times supporting the ethos of the multipurpose venue.

The works to date have included -

- Construction and fit out of new Vinci FM stadium offices
- Full electrical installation and support to internal events and IT teams
- Full electrical design and installation for Pitch Heating
- Emergency plumbing repairs
- Provision and installation of air conditioning and ventilation to various rooms
- Installation, replacement and upgrades to car park lighting
- Ventilation to the battery room to maintain compliant air flows
- Provision of labour (all trades) to carry out various general stadium maintenance and building works
